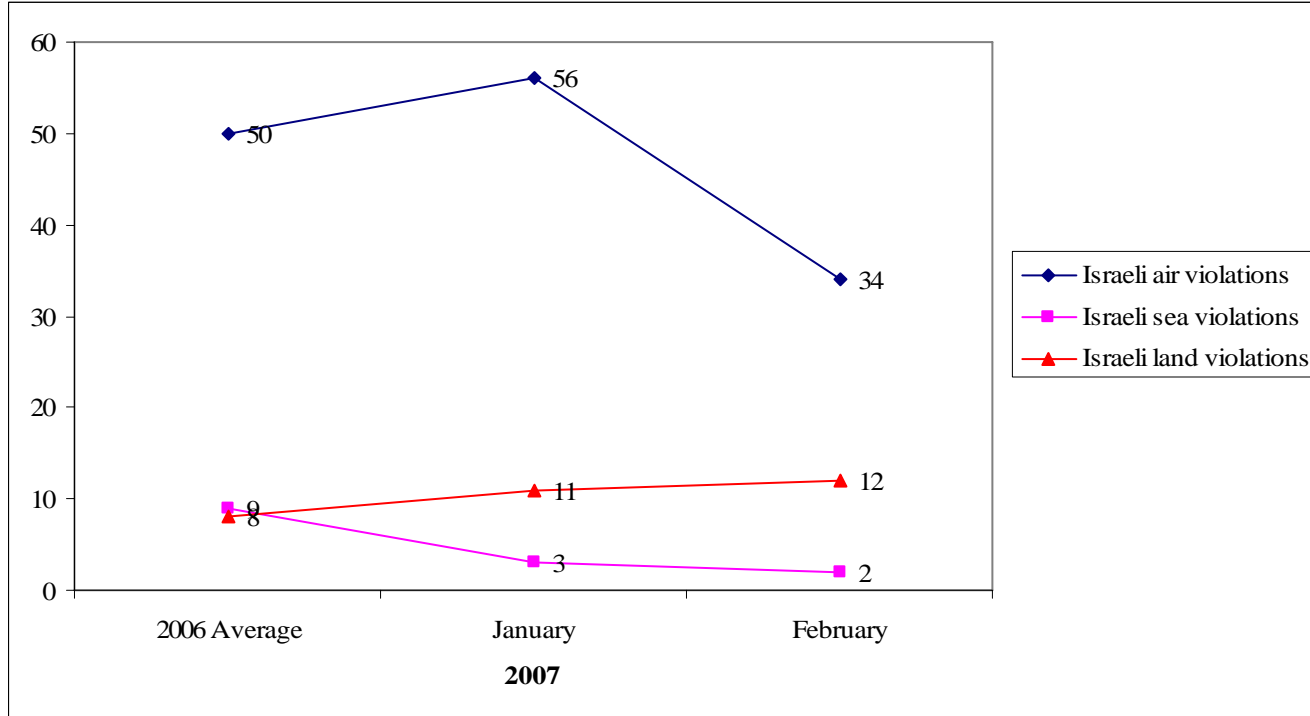

A D9 bulldozer and a trench-digger belonging to the Israeli enemy crossed the Blue Line. Immediately afterwards, an Army patrol proceeded to open fire in their direction. The bulldozer ceased work but the digger continued its work. Enemy forces then fired a LAU missile in the direction of a Lebanese Army vehicle, scoring a direct hit with no casualties resulting.
