**Re: Israeli violations, acts of aggression and activities from 15 to  
21 March 2007, inclusive**

*Air violations*

On 17 March 2007, between 1805 hours and 2155 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off al-Naqurah and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On the same date, between 1815 hours and 2205 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over the southern regions. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On 18 March 2007, between 1829 hours and 2148 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over regions of the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On the same date, at 2057 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre in an easterly direction and circled over the South and al-Damur. It then departed Lebanese airspace on 19 March 2007 at 0030 hours over al-Naqurah.

On 19 March 2007, between 0250 hours and 0600 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah. Between 0335 hours and 0630 hours, another reconnaissance aircraft also violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Bayadah in an easterly direction and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On the same date, between 0930 hours and 1040 hours, enemy Israeli warplanes overflew the towns of `Ayta al-Sha`b and Ramiya, and then overflew the town of Ramiya between 1250 hours and 1305 hours.

On the same date, between 1810 hours and 2315 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b and circled over regions of the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On the same date, at 2315 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over Rumaysh and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace on 20 March 2007 at 0430 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 20 March 2007, between 1729 hours and 2015 hours, an Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over the southern regions. It then departed Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On the same date, at 1939 hours, an Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off al-Naqurah and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace on 21 March 2007 at 0045 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On the same date, at 2015 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace on 21 March 2007 at 0105 hours over al-Naqurah.

On 21 March 2007, between 0800 hours and 1105 hours, a reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off al-Naqurah and circled over the South, Khaldah and Damur. It then departed Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On the same date, between 1500 hours and 1815 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over al-Damur, Sidon and Tyre. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On the same date, between 1735 hours and 2040 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On the same date, at 1800 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off al-Naqurah and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace on 22 March 2007 at 0040 hours over Rumaysh.

*Sea violations*

None reported.

*Field violations*

On 17 March 2007, at 2315 hours, four enemy Israeli vehicles shone their lights in the direction of Lebanese territory.

*Israeli activities*

On 15 March 2007, at 1720 hours, the Israeli enemy discharged light-weapons fire in the area next to its position opposite Balidah.

On 16 March 2007, at 1100 hours, the Israeli enemy discharged light-weapons fire south of al-Labunah.

On 18 March 2007, at 1000 hours, the Israeli enemy discharged light-weapons fire near the Radar outpost (opposite Shab`a).

On 19 March 2007, at 0430 hours, an enemy Israeli military launch fired three flare shells over the line of buoys inside Palestinian regional waters (opposite Ra's al-Naqurah).

On the same date, between 0900 hours and 1200 hours, the Israeli enemy discharged light-weapons fire near the Radar outpost (opposite Shab`a). At 1305 hours, it discharged similar fire in Zabdin farm (east of Kafr Shuba). At 1520 hours, it carried out combat drills using smoke bombs (south-west of `Ayta al-Sha`b).

On 21 March 2007, at 0800 hours, the Israeli enemy positioned several reinforced concrete bunkers in the occupied southern half of the town of Ghajar so as to command a view of the Wazzani river course.
