**Subject: Israeli violations, acts of aggression and activities from 22 to 31 May
2007, inclusive**

On 22 May 2007, six enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace and circled over areas of the North, Beirut, the South and the Bekaa as follows: At 1000 hours, two planes circled over `Alma al-Sha`b and then departed Lebanese airspace at 1145 hours over Rumaysh. At 1508 hours, two planes circled over Rumaysh and then departed Lebanese airspace at 1640 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b. At 2100 hours, two planes circled over the sea off Tyre and then departed Lebanese airspace at 2245 hours over the sea off al-Naqurah.

On 23 May 2007, between 0959 hours and 1025 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over Rumaysh. They flew as far as Baalbek and circled over areas of Baalbak, al-Harmal, al-Danniyah and Shikka. They then departed Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tripoli.

Between 1005 hours and 1030 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Juniyah in an easterly direction. They circled over areas of Baalbak, al-Harmal, al-Danniyah and Shikka. They then departed Lebanese airspace over the sea off al-Naqurah.

Between 1045 hours and 1100 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tripoli in an easterly direction as far as al-Danniyah. They then departed Lebanese airspace over Rumaysh.

Between 1555 hours and 1800 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre in a north-easterly direction. They circled over areas of Juniyah, Beirut and the South. They then departed Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 24 May 2007, between 1009 hours and 1040 hours, four Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the occupied Shab`a farmlands. They circled over areas of the western Bekaa and the South. They then departed Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 26 May 2007, between 0930 hours and 1345 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over areas of the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over Rumaysh.

Between 1335 hours and 1840 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over Tyre and circled over areas of the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

At 2155 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre in an easterly direction and circled over Beirut, al-Damur and the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace on 27 May 2007 at 0045 hours over Rumaysh.

On 27 May 2007, between 0900 hours and 1337 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off al-Naqurah and circled over the South. It then departed Lebanese airspace over `Alma al-Sha`b.

Between 2135 hours and 2325 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over the South area. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

On 28 May 2007, between 0110 hours and 0150 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the Bint Jubayl area at very high altitude.

On 30 May 2007, between 1925 hours and 2208 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace over the sea off Tyre and circled over the South, the Shuf, Beirut and Juniyah. It then departed Lebanese airspace over al-Naqurah.

Sea violations

On 23 May 2007, at 1145 hours, an enemy Israeli military launch fired several rounds of medium-weapons fire in the open sea off Ras al-Naqurah inside Lebanese territorial waters.

Field violations

On 28 May 2007, at 1010 hours, a Merkava tank and a trench-digger belonging to the Israeli enemy crossed the Green Line at the Jabal al-Sammaqah position (south of Kafr Shuba).

Israeli activities

On 24 May 2007, at 2329 hours, at the Dahr al`Asi outpost opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal, enemy Israeli forces proceeded to install radar.

On 26 May 2007, at 1220 hours, the Israeli enemy installed listening devices at the E-434 position opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal.
