Subject: Israeli violations, acts of aggression and other activities from 15 to 31 January 2009

Air violations

On 15 January 2009, at 0645 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Alma al-Sha`b. It circled over regions of the South, Beirut and Iqlim al-Kharrub, and departed on 16 January 2009 at 0510 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b.

Between 0918 hours and 1125 hours, four enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 2222 hours and 2330 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over the Shab`a farmlands. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over Kafr Kila.

At 2337 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Aytarun. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed on 16 January 2009 at 0015 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 16 January 2009, between 0725 hours and 1830 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Rumaysh and flying north. It circled over the South, and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 0900 hours and 1045 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Aytarun.

At 1900 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Alma al-Sha`b and flying north. It circled over regions of the South, and departed on 17 January 2009 at 1010 hours over Yarun.

Between 2100 hours and 2253 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Yarun and flying north. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over Rumaysh.

On 17 January 2009, between 1025 hours and 1132 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

At 2200 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Rumaysh and flying north. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed on 18 January 2009 at 0005 hours over al-Naqurah.

On 18 January 2009, between 1005 hours and 1205 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Aytarun. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 2103 hours and 2310 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Rumaysh. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 19 January 2009, between 1130 hours and 1330 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Aytarun and flying north as far as Tripoli. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

Between 1240 hours and 1400 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over the sea off al-Naqurah.

At 2305 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Aytarun. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed on 20 January 2009 at 0040 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 20 January 2009, between 1005 hours and 1100 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north as far as Baalbek-Hirmil. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over Kafr Kila.

On 21 January 2009, between 0930 hours and 1010 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over the occupied Shab`a farmlands. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

Between 0935 hours and 1100 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over the occupied Shab`a farmlands. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 22 January 2009, between 1158 hours and 1220 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Rumaysh and flying north as far as Shikka. They circled over Shikka, Jubayl, Rayak and al-Hirmil, and departed over the sea off Tripoli.

Between 1440 hours and 2200 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over `Alma al-Sha`b and flying north. It circled over all regions of the South, and departed over Rumaysh.

On 23 January 2009, between 0700 hours and 1400 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north. It circled over all regions of the South, and departed over `Alma al-Sh`ab.

Between 1515 hours and 1645 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 25 January 2009, between 1055 hours and 2025 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north as far as Tyre. It circled over regions of the South, and departed over al-Naqurah.

On 26 January 2009, between 0600 hours and 1225 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and

flying north as far as Beirut. It circled over Beirut, the South and the Bekaa, and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 1540 hours and 1745 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Rumaysh and flying as far as Tripoli. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed over `Alma al-Sha`b.

Between 1908 hours and 2100 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying as far as Shikka. They circled over all Lebanese regions and fired three flare shells over the Na`imah hills. They departed over Rumaysh.

At 2230 hours, two enemy Israeli warplanes violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north as far as Tripoli. They circled over all Lebanese regions, and departed on 27 January 2009 at 0045 hours over `Alma al-Sha`b.

On 28 January 2009, between 1200 hours and 2050 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north. It circled over the southern regions, and departed over Rumaysh.

Sea violations

On 15 January 2009, at 2000 hours, an enemy Israeli launch in the open sea inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters shone a searchlight in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters for 15 seconds.

On 20 January 2009, at 1745 hours, an enemy Israeli launch shone a searchlight in the direction of a Lebanese fishing boat located 700 metres north of the first buoy.

On 22 January 2009, at 2117 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for 20 seconds from its position south of al-Naqurah in the direction of a Lebanese fishing boat located 50 metres north of the first buoy.

On 24 January 2009, at 2330 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for five seconds from its position east of al-Naqurah in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters north of the first and second buoys.

Ground violations

On 27 January 2009, between 1650 hours and 1730 hours, enemy Israeli forces fired several rounds of medium and light machine-gun fire from their position in al-Sammaqah inside the occupied Shab`a farmlands into the area around the position.
