Subject: Israeli violations, acts of aggression and other activities from
1 to 31 July 2009

Air violations

On 1 July 2009, between 0718 hours and 1915 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north as far as Nabatiyah. It circled over regions of the South, and departed over Rumaysh.

On 4 July 2009, between 0615 hours and 1155 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over the sea off Sidon and flying east as far as the Bekaa. It circled over Rayak and regions of the South, and departed over Kafr Kila.

On 5 July 2009, between 0645 hours and 1520 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah. It circled over the South, al-Hirmil, al-Arz, Rayak and Baalbek, and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 0720 hours and 1930 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over 'Alma al-Sha'b and flying northeast. It circled over regions of the South, and departed over Rumaysh.

On 6 July 2009, between 1000 hours and 1140 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over al-Naqurah.

Between 0710 hours and 1850 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah. It circled over regions of the South, Rayak, Baalbek and al-Hirmil, and departed over al-Naqurah.

On 15 July 2009, between 1140 hours and 1835 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over 'Alma al-Sha'b and flying north. It circled over the southern regions and Beirut, and departed over al-Naqurah.

On 18 July 2009, between 0800 hours and 2035 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah. It circled over regions of the South, and departed over al-Naqurah.

On 19 July 2009, between 0830 hours and 2245 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah. It circled over regions of the South and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 1010 hours and 1140 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north as far as Shikka. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over 'Alma al-Sha'b.

On 20 July 2009, between 1010 hours and 1145 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over the sea off al-Naqurah.

Between 1305 hours and 1345 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over the sea off Juniyah and flying east. They circled between Shikka and Beirut over sea and land, and departed over Yarun.

On 21 July 2009, between 0610 hours and 1540 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Rumaysh. It circled over regions of the South and departed over al-Naqurah.

On 23 July 2009, between 0800 hours and 1455 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north as far as al-Hirmil. It circled over regions of Baalbek-Hirmil, and departed over al-Naqurah.

At 0830 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north as far as Sidon. It circled over regions of the South, and departed on 24 July 2009 at 0330 hours over 'Alma al-Sha'b.

On 25 July 2009, at 0845 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north-east. It circled over the regions of Baalbek, Rayak and al-Hirmil, and departed on 26 July 2009 at 0050 hours over Kafr Kila.

On 26 July 2009, between 1020 hours and 1130 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over 'Alma al-Sha'b. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over Rumaysh.

On 27 July 2009, between 1025 hours and 1215 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over 'Alma al-Sha'b.

At 1415 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah. It circled over the regions of the South and Beirut, and departed on 28 July 2009 at 0030 hours over Rumaysh.

On 28 July 2009, between 1030 hours and 1115 hours, four enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north as far as Shikka. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over Rumaysh.

Between 1040 hours and 1205 hours, two enemy Israeli military aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over Kafr Kila and flying north as far as Tripoli. They circled over all regions of Lebanon, and departed over al-Naqurah.

Between 0845 hours and 1530 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah and flying north as far as Nabatiyah. It circled over the South, and departed over al-Naqurah.

On 30 July 2009, between 0714 hours and 2040 hours, an enemy Israeli reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over al-Naqurah. It circled over the South and Beirut, and departed over al-Naqurah.

Sea violations

On 1 July 2009, at 0105 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters approximately 400 metres north of the first buoy four separate times for five seconds each time.

At 0140 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for five seconds from its Ra's al-Naqurah position in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters approximately 400 metres north of the fifth buoy.

On 15 July 2009, at 2215 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for five seconds from its Ra's al-Naqurah position in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters and at the Lebanese Army position in Ra's al-Naqurah.

On 16 July 2009, at 2225 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for five seconds from its Ra's al-Naqurah position in the direction of a Lebanese fishing vessel located 50 metres inside Lebanese territorial waters opposite the third buoy.

On 24 July 2009, at 2315 hours, personnel at the Lebanese Army's LM-6 observation post on the beach at Qulaylah observed several hot air balloons being dropped over the open sea by an Israeli enemy military aircraft that was not visible.

On 25 July 2009, at 0355 hours, the Israeli enemy fired three warning rounds of medium-weapons fire from its Ra's al-Naqurah position into the air over a Lebanese fishing vessel as it approached to within 30 metres of the first buoy inside Lebanese territorial waters, forcing it to leave the area.

On 26 July 2009, at 0400 hours, from the open sea off Ra's al-Naqurah inside Palestinian territorial waters, an enemy Israeli military launch shone a searchlight for six seconds in the direction of a Lebanese fishing vessel approximately 50 metres from the sixth buoy, thereby violating Lebanese territorial waters.

On 30 July 2009, at 0125 hours, from the open sea off Ra's al-Naqurah inside Palestinian territorial waters, an enemy Israeli military launch shone a searchlight for five seconds in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters.

Ground violations

On 5 July 2009, at 1930 hours, telephone calls were received on mobile phones in the western Bekaa area, offering a 10 million dollar reward to anyone providing information on the Israeli soldiers missing in Lebanon.

At 2033 hours, the Israeli enemy stationed at the Zar'it barracks shone a searchlight for five minutes in the direction of the Lebanese Army position at Jabal Balat (Marwahin).

On 6 July 2009, at 1140 hours, an enemy Israeli patrol stopped at the Fatimah gate in Kafr Kila. Two soldiers disembarked and took photographs of the Lebanese Army position and civilian automobiles.

On 7 July 2009, at 1210 hours, an enemy Israeli patrol took photographs of the Wardah rest spot inside Lebanese territory near the Lebanese Army position at Kafr Kila, and departed when it was finished.

At 1600 hours, an enemy Israeli patrol consisting of two jeeps departed the Misgav Am outpost. When it arrived opposite the Lebanese Army checkpoint at

'Adaysah, a civilian disembarked from the forward jeep and began to photograph the checkpoint and the nearby observation post manned by the Indonesian contingent of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL). The photographing went on for approximately two minutes, after which the patrol departed.

On 15 July 2009, at various times, several telephone calls in Hebrew were received from the Israeli enemy on fixed and mobile networks in various regions of the South, offering the sum of 10 million American dollars in exchange for information on the missing Israeli soldiers.

On 17 July 2009, at 2035 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for one minute from its Zar'it barracks position in the direction of Lebanese territory.

On 21 July 2009, at 2020 hours, the Israeli enemy shone a searchlight for 20 seconds from its Zar'it barracks position in the direction of the Lebanese Army position in Tarbikha (Marwahin).

On 30 July 2009, at 1405, two dogs from the Israeli enemy's 'Abbad position crossed the technical fence in the direction of Lebanese territory. They were driven back by LM-11 personnel, one of whom fired in their direction without hitting or capturing them.
