Ground violations committed in September 2016

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
4 September	0700 1700	The Israeli enemy continued the work begun on 15 August 2016 outside the technical fence in the locality of Saddanah, near observation point OP3 of the Indian contingent of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL), towards Birkat al-Naqqar. The enemy carried out the work using two excavators, four jackhammer vehicles and a bulldozer escorted by six AIL Storm vehicles and one Hummer vehicle. The Israeli enemy subsequently finished work and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
5 September	0627 1645	The Israeli enemy continued the work begun on 15 August 2016 outside the technical fence in the locality of Saddanah, near observation point OP3 of the Indian contingent of UNIFIL, towards Birkat al-Naqqar. The enemy carried out the work using four jackhammer vehicles, three excavators and two bulldozers escorted by two AIL Storm vehicles, six soldiers and a personnel carrier. The Israeli enemy subsequently finished its work and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
6 September	0620 0626 1620 1615	The sound of several explosions was heard in the Shab'a Farms. The Israeli enemy continued the work begun on 15 August 2016 outside the technical fence in the locality of Saddanah, near observation point OP3 of the Indian contingent of UNIFIL, towards Birkat al-Naqqar. The enemy carried out the work using four jackhammer vehicles, two excavators and a bulldozer escorted by an AIL Storm vehicle and six soldiers. The Israeli enemy subsequently finished its work and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory. Inside occupied Palestinian territory, four Israeli enemy soldiers installed a surveillance camera on a transmission tower within their position opposite Ra's Naqurah and pointed it towards Lebanese territory. The Israeli enemy army finished work at 1725 hours and withdrew in the direction of occupied territory.
8 September	1200	A shepherd reported seeing a suspicious item on the outskirts of Shab'a town, near observation point OP1 of the Indian contingent of UNIFIL. A Lebanese Army patrol went to the location and found some metal pegs planted in the ground. The pegs were part of a surveillance device which the Israeli enemy had previously planted on Lebanese territory and has recently removed.
13 September	0530 0830	Several explosions were heard within the occupied Shab'a Farms. From its positions at Ramta and Summaqah, the Israeli enemy directed machine-gun and medium-weapons fire at the surroundings.

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
19 September	1700	The Israeli enemy installed a camera opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal in the Kurum al-Shiraqi area, between points B64 and B64-1, 10 metres south of the Blue Line. The camera was fixed to a cube that was camouflaged to look like a rock. It was directed towards Lebanese territory.
26 September	1230	The Israeli enemy continued the work begun on 15 August in the occupied Shab'a Farms, beyond the technical fence, at the locations of Saddanah and Jabal al-Shahl, in the direction of the Radar position. The enemy carried out the work using two D9 bulldozers escorted by a hostile patrol comprising two personnel carriers, two Merkava tanks and 25 soldiers who took up positions on the surrounding hills. The Israeli enemy finished work at 1630 hours.
27 September	0930	The Israeli enemy continued the work begun on 15 August in the occupied Shab'a Farms, beyond the technical fence, in the locations of Saddanah and Jabal al-Shahl, in the direction of the Radar position. The enemy carried out the work using two trench diggers escorted by a patrol comprising a Merkava tank and 15 soldiers who took up positions on the surrounding hills. The Israeli enemy finished work and the vehicles withdrew in the direction of occupied territory at 1630 hours.
29 September	1350	An Israeli enemy patrol comprising a Defender vehicle, a Hummer pick-up truck, a steamroller, a trench digger and three soldiers carried out maintenance work along the technical fence opposite the Lebanese Army checkpoint of Udaysah. Members of the patrol trained their weapons on Lebanese territory. The Israeli enemy finished work and withdrew in the direction of occupied territory at 1530 hours.

Sea violations committed in September 2016

3 September	1716	Off Ra's al-Naqrarah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) of 1 October 2011, for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 240 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
4 September	1813	Off Ra's al-Naqrarah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 200 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
5 September	0938	Off Ra's al-Naqrarah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a 42-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 205 metres. Enemy divers descended from the launch and carried out maintenance work on the second and third buoys. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1055 hours, it again violated the boundary, for an 18-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 300 metres. It then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	1825	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 260 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1920	An Israeli enemy launch inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters released an explosive charge into occupied Palestinian territorial waters. The crew used a loudspeaker to call out in Hebrew to the crew of a Lebanese fishing vessel that was located inside Lebanese territorial waters.
6 September	0344	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for an eight-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 330 metres. The crew directed a searchlight at Lebanese territorial waters and used a loudspeaker to call out in Hebrew to the crew of a Lebanese fishing vessel that was located inside Lebanese territorial waters.
	0400	From its position in occupied Palestinian territory opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the
	0430	Israeli enemy twice directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters, first for 30 seconds and then for 40 seconds.
	1748	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 350 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
10 September	1905	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 240 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
11 September	0230	From inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters at its position opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for a period of five minutes.
	1824	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 130 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
12 September	0457	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a five-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 425 metres. The crew launched an explosive device into Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	1822	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a one-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 205 metres. At 1831 hours, it violated the boundary again, for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 205 metres. It then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
14 September	1010	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a two-hour-and-50-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 500 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1805	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 295 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
15 September	1006	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for an eight-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 110 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1034 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 200 metres. It then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1855	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 204 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
16 September	1810	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 150 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
17 September	0847	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 110 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1818 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for 185 metres. It then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
