Land violations committed during May 2017

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
3 May	0930	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using three trench-diggers and a D9 bulldozer. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol, and two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. The work ended at 1900 hours, and the patrol left in the direction of occupied territory.
4 May	0830 1000	Several explosions were heard from inside the occupied Shab'a Farms.
	0930	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using three trench-diggers and a D9 bulldozer. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol, and two Merkava tanks took up position on the hills opposite the road. At 1730 hours, some of the personnel left in the direction of occupied territory. An enemy patrol remained in position near the machines.
5 May	1507	Outside of the town of Shab'a, in the vicinity of Jabal al-Shahal, while the herder Mahir Hamdan was tending to a herd of goats, an Israeli enemy patrol crossed the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line that demarcates area with regard to which Lebanon maintains a claim) by a distance of some 50 metres and attempted unsuccessfully to abduct the herd. The enemy patrol fired their weapons in the air without injuring anyone.
7 May	0930	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using four trench-diggers and a D9 bulldozer. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol, and two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. At 1800 hours, some of the personnel left in the direction of occupied territory. An enemy patrol remained in position near the machines.
	1440	While an Observer Group Lebanon team was conducting a routine patrol along the Blue Line near point B83, in the town of Kafr Killa, an Israeli enemy Merkava tank at the position of Jabal al-Tayyarah pointed its cannon towards the team and Lebanese territory.
8 May	0930	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using four trench-diggers and a D9 bulldozer. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol, and two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. At 1800 hours, some of the personnel left in the direction of occupied territory. An enemy patrol remained in position near the machines.
	1430	A six-person Israeli enemy patrol arrived at point 18- <i>shin</i> , the Shaykh Abbad position inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Hula, and carried out maintenance work a repeater at that location. Two enemy personnel trained their weapons on Lebanese Army soldiers. They then installed a camera on the technical fence and pointed it at Lebanese territory. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1730 hours.

9 May	0930	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using four trench-diggers and a D9 bulldozer. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol, and two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. At 1800 hours, some of the personnel left in the direction of occupied territory. An enemy patrol remained in position near the machines.
	1200	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, enemy Israeli forces used a forklift to install metal netting west of the Radar position. The Israeli enemy finished work at 1335 hours.
10 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using four trench diggers and two D9 bulldozers. The workers, who were accompanied by an enemy patrol, used a winch to install a metal fence. Enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory. The Israeli enemy finished work at 1700 hours.
	1330	An Israeli enemy patrol comprising two Hummer vehicles arrived in the area between points B85 and B86 opposite the town of Kafr Killa, inside occupied Palestinian territory. Four individuals in military uniform and three in civilian clothing stepped out and began measuring the road. One of them trained his weapon on a Lebanese Army patrol and directed abuse at the patrol. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1530 hours.
	1700	The Israeli enemy set fire to dry grass in occupied territory opposite the town of Abbasiyah. The fire spread to Abbasiyah, in Lebanese territory. Civil defence personnel and members of the Spanish contingent of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) put out the fire, which had spread over a distance of five dunams.
11 May	1000	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench diggers and two D9 bulldozers. The workers, who were accompanied by an enemy patrol, used a winch to continue the work of installing a metal fence that had begun on 10 May 2017. Enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory. The Israeli enemy finished work at 1730 hours.
14 May	1000	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench diggers and two D9 bulldozers, and the workers were accompanied by an enemy patrol. Enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory. The Israeli enemy finished work at 1800 hours.
	2000 2040	Several explosions were heard from inside the occupied Shab'a Farms.
15 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, and the workers were accompanied by a 30-person enemy foot patrol. A Merkava tank took up position on the hills opposite the road. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.

16 May	1000	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench diggers and two D9 bulldozers, and the workers were accompanied by an enemy patrol that deployed near the location. A Merkava tank took up position on the hills opposite the road. During the work, enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.
17 May	1000	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol that deployed in the area, and two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.
18 May	1200	On the outskirts of the locality of Jabal al-Shahl, outside the town of Shab'a, near point OP2 of the Indian contingent of UNIFIL, a seven-person Israeli enemy patrol crossed the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line in the area to which Lebanon maintains a claim) by a distance of some 100 metres. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1330 hours.
19 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers. The workers were escorted by an enemy foot patrol that deployed in the area. The Israeli enemy finished work at 1700 hours.
	1510	Outside of the town of Shab'a, near the locality of Jabal al-Shahal, while the herder Mahir Hamdan was tending to a herd of goats, an Israeli enemy patrol comprising three soldiers crossed the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line that demarcates area with regard to which Lebanon maintains a claim) and attempted unsuccessfully to abduct the aforementioned herder. They took approximately 650 goats with them back into occupied territory. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy returned the herd of goats.
21 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using a trench digger and a D9 bulldozer, and the workers were accompanied by an enemy patrol that deployed near the location. Two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. During the work, enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory. At 1830 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.
22 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench diggers and two D9 bulldozers, and the workers were accompanied by an enemy patrol that deployed near the location. Two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. During the work, enemy trucks transported gravel and spread it on the road. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.

23 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench diggers and two D9 bulldozers, and the workers were accompanied by a 30-person enemy patrol that deployed near the location. During the work, enemy trucks transported gravel and spread it on the road. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.
24 May	0900	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, and the workers were accompanied by a 30-person enemy foot patrol. At the same time, two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. At 1200 hours, eight cement blocks were installed next to the metal gate on the road to the old Shahl post in the occupied Shab'a Farms opposite observation post OP2 of the Indian contingent of UNIFIL, outside the town of Shab'a. At 1830 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.
25 May	0830	The same team resumed the previous day's work until 1730 hours, when the personnel left and the machines remained in place.
	1430	Some 40 people carrying signs celebrating Resistance and Liberation Day approached the farm of Sardah-Marj Uyun, near point 64-9 of the Spanish unit of UNIFIL. From inside occupied Palestinian territory, the Israeli enemy launched smoke grenades that landed on Lebanese territory, started a fire and cause five of the landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy to explode. There were no injuries. At 2030 hours, the fire went out.
27 May	1900	A three-person Israeli enemy patrol approached the Kafr Killa highway near crossing point B82 and intimidated and shouted obscene language at civilians on the Lebanese side. At 1920 hours, they returned into occupied territory.
28 May	0830	The Israeli enemy continued the dirt road construction work that began on 27 April 2017 in the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the stretch from the locality of Jabal al-Shahl to the Radar position. The work was carried out using five trench-diggers, two D9 bulldozers and four trucks, which transported earth from the building site to another nearby site. The machines were accompanied by an enemy patrol that deployed in the area. At the same time, two Merkava tanks took up positions on the hills opposite the road. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy finished work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory. The machines remained in place.
29 May	0900	The same team resumed the previous day's work until 1730 hours, when the personnel left and the machines remained in place.

	0511	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) of 1 October 2011 for a one-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 260 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0516 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a nine-minute period, and proceeded on its way for 295 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0531 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a 32-minute period, and proceeded on its way for 295 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0638 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a six-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 260 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0646 hours, it returned and again violated the boundary, for a 51-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 463 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0740 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a 37-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 350 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
2 May	0425	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for two minutes.
	0428	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011), proceeding some 185 metres into Lebanese territorial waters over a seven-minute period before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0502 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a 24-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 200 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0452	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for a two-minute period and broadcast over loudspeakers in Arabic.
3 May	0420	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 38-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 780 metres before leaving occupied Palestinian territorial waters. It returned at 0505 hours and breached the boundary for a two-minute period, proceeding on its way for some 170 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1428	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 44-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 334 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1517 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a 23-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 370 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1623 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a 12-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 260 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
4 May	0252	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for one minute.

	0451	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 355 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0500	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position towards Lebanese territorial waters.
	0502	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for two minutes.
	0832	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 350 metres. A crew member released an explosive charge from the launch within occupied Palestinian territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
6 May	0405	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position towards Lebanese territorial waters.
	0415	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position towards Lebanese territorial waters for a four-minute period.

10 May	0340 0445	From inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for three periods of 20 minutes, 48 minutes and two minutes.
	0352	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 21-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 296 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 0439 hours, it returned and violated the boundary for a 39-minute period, proceeding on its way for some 314 metres. A crew member released an explosive charge in Lebanese territorial waters and sounded a warning siren. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1821 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for 75 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
11 May	1020	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a period of two hours and 20 minutes, proceeded on its way for some 100 metres into Lebanese territorial waters, and released two divers before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1215	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 17-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 185 metres into Lebanese territorial water before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1223	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 13-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 300 metres into Lebanese territorial waters before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	1825	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 260 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
13 May	2014	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 333 metres into Lebanese territorial waters before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 2022 hours, it violated the boundary again for a six-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 296 metres into Lebanese territorial waters before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 2104 hours, it again violated the boundary, for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 166 metres into Lebanese territorial waters before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 2138 hours, it returned and violated the boundary again for an 18-minute period, proceeding some 370 metres into Lebanese territorial waters before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	1400	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 20-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 50 metres before leaving in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
