**Land violations committed in July 2017**

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
2 July	0900	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. Earthen berms were raised along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest, along with a mechanized patrol, remained at the location with the construction vehicles.
	1800	As the civilian Shibli Abd Isa was herding livestock 40 metres from the Blue Line on the outskirts of the town of Ramiya, a landmine that had been left behind by the Israeli enemy exploded, injuring him critically and severing his left foot. He died of his injuries at 0300 hours on 3 July 2017.
3 July	0900	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers, two D9 bulldozers and three trucks, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 25 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. Earthen berms were raised along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory in order to obstruct the view. The work ended at 1800 hours. Some of the soldiers left and headed into occupied territory, while the construction vehicles and a mechanized patrol remained in place.
4 July	0900	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers, two D9 bulldozers and three trucks, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 25 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. The enemy also raised earthen berms along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory in order to obstruct the view. The work ended at 1800 hours. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest remained at the location with the construction vehicles.

5 July	0900	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers, two D9 bulldozers and three trucks, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest remained at the location with the construction vehicles.
6 July	0830	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers, two D9 bulldozers and three trucks, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 25 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. Earthen berms were raised along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest remained at the location with the construction vehicles.
	1300	As the shepherd Ismail Zahra was tending to a herd of livestock on the outskirts of the town of Shab'a, in the Jabal Shahal area (Khallah al-Wasi'ah), an Israeli enemy foot patrol tried but failed to kidnap him. He fled with his herd in the direction of the town of Shab'a. During the attempted kidnapping, two members of the patrol violated the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line that demarcates territory with respect to which Lebanon maintains a claim) by some 20 metres. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory.
9 July	0830	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers, two D9 bulldozers and three trucks to transport the soil. The construction vehicles which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 20 soldiers who deployed near the site. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. Earthen berms were raised along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers returned into occupied territory, but the construction vehicles and the mechanized patrol remained in place.

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
	1030	In the Ruwaysat al-Alam locality on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba, an Israeli enemy patrol comprising approximately 12 soldiers positioned itself near the Ruwaysat al-Alam position. Four soldiers violated the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line that demarcates territory with respect to which Lebanon maintains a claim), entering some 50 metres into liberated Lebanese territory. At 1100 hours they departed in the direction of the aforementioned position.
10 July	0830	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. In the course of the construction work, some Israeli enemy trucks brought in gravel and spread it on the dirt road and raised earthen berms along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest, along with a mechanized patrol, remained at the location with the construction vehicles.
11 July	0900	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, in the Jabal al-Shahal area near the Radar position, the Israeli enemy continued work on a dirt road that it had begun building on 27 April 2017. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction site. Earthen berms were raised along the side of the road that faces liberated Lebanese territory. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest remained at the location with the construction vehicles.
12 July	0705-0800	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, opposite the town of Maysat, the Israeli enemy pointed a Merkava tank cannon towards Lebanese territory.
	1000	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Alma al-Sha'b, the Israeli enemy installed a new surveillance camera atop the transmission tower at position <i>ghayn-23</i> west of Adami (Cobra position).
17 July	1440	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah (at the Panorama point), an Israeli enemy patrol comprising a Defender vehicle, a pickup truck and a civilian Rapid vehicle approached. Three soldiers disembarked and mounted a camera atop a 10-metre pole. They then pointed the camera towards Lebanese territory. At 1520 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work and the vehicles and the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory.

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
18 July	0800	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the Kafr Killa-Udaysah road, an Israeli enemy patrol comprising a Defender vehicle, a pickup truck and a civilian Rapid vehicle approached. Three soldiers disembarked and mounted a camera atop a 10-metre pole. They then pointed the camera towards Lebanese territory. At 1230 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work and the vehicles and soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory.
	0900	As Nidal Ahmad Salhab (who works for a Norwegian demining organization) was clearing minefield No. 575 on the outskirts of the town of Tayr Harfa, in Tyre district, an M77 cluster bomb left behind by the Israeli enemy exploded. He was struck by bomb fragments and his right hand was injured.
	1730	As Mukhawwal Mukhawwal was tending to a herd of livestock on the outskirts of the towns of Ayta al-Sha'b and Rumaysh, a landmine left behind by the Israeli enemy exploded and killed two goats.
20 July	1630-1800	Inside the occupied Shab'a Farms, from their post at the Radar position, Israeli enemy forces directed several bursts of light- and medium-weapon fire at the surrounding area.
22 July	1730	From inside occupied territory, opposite Sahl al-Khiyam, an Israeli enemy patrol comprising a Hummer vehicle and a pickup truck approached. Four soldiers disembarked and carried out maintenance work on the technical fence. The patrol left at 1915 hours and headed towards occupied territory.
25 July	1630	From inside occupied Palestinian territory, at the Shaykh Abbad position opposite Hula, an Israeli enemy pickup truck equipped with a surveillance camera and carrying eight soldiers approached. The soldiers pointed the camera at Lebanese territory. Two soldiers carried out maintenance work on the transmission tower at the aforementioned position. The vehicles and soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory at 1930 hours.

	1943	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) of 1 October 2011 for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 190 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
4 July	0200	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, the crew of an Israeli enemy military launch opened fire with military weapons in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters.
	0200	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for a 30-minute period.
	0920	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a five-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 330 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
6 July	0325-0550	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position towards Lebanese territorial waters.
	0325-0550	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, the crew of an Israeli enemy military launch opened fire with military weapons in the direction of Lebanese territorial waters.
	0922	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a five-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 85 metres. The crew of that launch used a loudspeaker to warn off a Lebanese fishing vessel that was inside Lebanese territorial waters, with a view to driving towards the north. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
7 July	1830	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a one-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 270 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
9 July	1815	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 185 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

10 July	0932	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 15-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 85 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
11 July	0945	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 350 metres, sounding warning sirens and broadcasting over loudspeakers in Hebrew. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
12 July	0845	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 203 metres, sounding warning sirens. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1225	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 20-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 50 metres, releasing a diver opposite the first buoy. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1310	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 35-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 330 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1850	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a four-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 297 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
13 July	0905	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a five-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 260 metres into Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1050	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a period of one hour and five minutes, proceeding some 190 metres into Lebanese territorial waters. It released two divers and towed the so-called second buoy. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	1203	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 30-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 315 metres into Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1220	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 15-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 278 metres into Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
14 July	0930	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a five-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 350 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1920	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a one-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 370 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
15 July	0451	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 12-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 480 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0515	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a period of one hour and 40 minutes, and proceeded on its way for some 140 metres. The launch warned off a Lebanese fishing vessel that was inside Lebanese territorial waters by sounding warning sirens, directing a searchlight and detonating noise bombs inside Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
16 July	0453	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 10-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 480 metres. It directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for a period of two minutes. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0620-0630	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, the crew of an Israeli enemy military launch sounded warning sirens several times and detonated a noise bomb inside Lebanese territorial waters.

The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
18 July	0225	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position towards Lebanese territorial waters for a three-minute period.
	0225-0313	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, from inside occupied Palestinian territorial waters, the crew of an Israeli enemy military launch directed a searchlight towards Lebanese territorial waters for a 29-minute period and then again for a two-minute period. The crew also sounded warning sirens and broadcast over loudspeakers in Hebrew.
	0240	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, two Israeli enemy military launches violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 35-minute period, and proceeded on their way for some 185 metres. They used a loudspeaker to warn off a Lebanese fishing vessel that was inside Lebanese territorial waters and directed a searchlight towards it to drive it north. The launches then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1051	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, the Israeli enemy directed a searchlight from its Ra's al-Naqurah position towards Lebanese territorial waters for a six-minute period.
	1051	Opposite Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 29-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 370 metres into Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters. At 1110 hours, it violated the boundary again for a six-minute period, proceeding on its way for some 350 metres.
