Land violations committed in March 2021

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
1 March	1435	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Killa, two Israeli enemy civilian vehicles approached. Eight individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. Then they entered the shack located at that site and spent about five minutes inside. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1450 hours.
	2000 2030	Israeli enemy personnel fired 26 flares over the occupied parts of the towns of Ghajar and Abbasiyah. Four hostile vehicles were seen moving south of the technical fence between Ghajar and Abbasiyah.
2 March	1140	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Killa, at the Israeli enemy Jabal al-Tayyarah position, a civilian bus approached. Some 30 individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1230 hours.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Bustan, the DanChurchAid organization detonated eight landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Alma al-Sha‘b, the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) detonated nine landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Arab al-Luwayzah, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 21 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Mays al-Jabal, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 16 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Amra, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 33 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
3 March	0845	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Maysat, six Israeli enemy personnel crossed the technical fence and conducted a foot patrol in the direction of the Wazzani river. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 0850 hours.
	1220 1310	Explosions of unknown origin were heard coming from inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms while a helicopter circled overhead.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Bustan, the DanChurchAid organization detonated nine landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Alma al-Sha‘b, UNIFIL detonated a landmine left behind by the Israeli enemy.

		– In Lebanese territory in the town of Yarun, the Norwegian People’s Aid organization detonated 20 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
		– In Lebanese territory in the town of Arab al-Luwayzah, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated nine landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
		– In Lebanese territory in the town of Mays al-Jabal, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 30 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
		– In Lebanese territory in the town of Markaba, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 16 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
4 March	0730	In occupied Palestinian territory, at the Israeli enemy’s two positions opposite the towns of Kafr Killa and Markaba, enemy soldiers pointed the cannons of two Merkava tanks towards Lebanese territory until 0820 hours.
	1425	In occupied Palestinian territory, at the Israeli enemy position opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal, a Merkava tank approached. It deployed behind the earthen berm at point B64 along the technical fence. At 1430 hours, it pointed its cannon at Lebanese army personnel located inside Lebanese territory. It released its camouflage smoke and then moved along the dirt road parallel to the technical fence between points BP30 and BP30(1). It stopped for 10 minutes and again pointed its cannon at Lebanese army personnel. It left into the enemy Dahr al-Asi position at 1550 hours.
		– In Lebanese territory in the town of Alma al-Sha’b, UNIFIL detonated 12 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
5 March	1055	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Killa, at the Israeli enemy Jabal al-Tayyarah position, two civilian cars and a bus approached. Some 35 individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1130 hours.
	1200	At the Israeli enemy position east of Mays al-Jabal opposite point BP31, two drones circled overhead. At 1230 hours a Humvee vehicle approached. Four personnel in military uniform disembarked and deployed behind the earthen berm. They pointed their firearms for 10 minutes towards Lebanese territory at two Lebanese army patrols and the Nepalese UNIFIL contingent. The enemy patrol left and the two drones returned to the aforementioned position at 1250 hours.
	1300	In Lebanese territory, next to UNIFIL post 31-1 in Labbunah, the Chinese UNIFIL contingent detonated 16 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	1430	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite points B64 and B64(1) and the town of Mays al-Jabal, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of three military vehicles approached. Six personnel in military uniform disembarked. Two of them performed maintenance on the technical fence without breaching it while the others deployed behind the earthen berm and took up combat positions. Two of the personnel pointed their firearms at two Lebanese army patrols and the Nepalese UNIFIL contingent. The enemy patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1650 hours.

	1613	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP36(2), two Israeli enemy civilian cars approached. Some four individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1630 hours.
	1640	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite point BP31 and the town of Mays al-Jabal, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of two Humvee vehicles approached. Seven personnel in military uniform disembarked, deployed behind the earthen berm and took up combat positions. They pointed their firearms towards Lebanese territory at two Lebanese Army patrols and the Nepalese UNIFIL contingent. Enemy personnel also pointed a 12.7 mm machine gun mounted on one of the vehicles towards Lebanese territory. The enemy patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1700 hours.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Bustan, the DanChurchAid organization detonated 12 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Alma al-Sha‘b, UNIFIL detonated 16 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
6 March	1330	In occupied Palestinian territory, near Barad al-Tuffah opposite Sahl al-Khiyam, an Israeli enemy civilian bus approached. Some 20 personnel in military uniform disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1340 hours.
7 March	1355 1500	Bursts of light- and medium-weapon fire were heard from inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms and the area surrounding the Summaqah position,
	1430	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, at the Israeli enemy Humayri position, a group consisting of seven individuals in military and civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1455 hours.
	1615	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP36(2), two Israeli enemy civilian busses approached. Some 40 individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1640 hours.
8 March	1030	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Killa, at the Israeli enemy Jabal al-Tayyarah position, an Israeli enemy civilian bus approached. Some 25 individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1100 hours.
	1300	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Killa, at the Israeli enemy Jabal al-Tayyarah position, two civilian busses and 12 civilian cars approached. Some 100 personnel in military uniform and some journalists disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1350 hours.

	1340	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP36(2), nine Israeli enemy vehicles approached. Some eight personnel in military uniform and 10 individuals in civilian clothing disembarked, scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1550 hours.
	1520	In occupied territory, on the outskirts of the town of Mays al-Jabal near point BP31, two Humvee vehicles approached. Nine personnel in military uniform disembarked. Five of them deployed behind the earthen berm, took up combat positions and pointed their firearms towards Lebanese territory at Lebanese army personnel and the Nepalese UNIFIL contingent. At 1600 hours, from the Israeli enemy position east of Jabal al-Tayyarah, a civilian car approached. Eight personnel in military uniform disembarked and deployed behind the earthen berm. At the same time, a drone circled overhead, breaching the technical fence between points B64(1) and BP31 without violating Lebanese airspace. The enemy patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1745 hours.
	2000	From inside occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Udaysah, near point TP36, Israeli enemy personnel set up two searchlights behind the cement wall, turned them on, and directed them towards Lebanese territory.
	2310	At the southern edge of the town of Mays al-Jabal, near point B64, an Israeli soldier fired a flare in the direction of Lebanese territory.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Bustan, the DanChurchAid organization detonated eight landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Alma al-Sha‘b, UNIFIL detonated 18 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Mays al-Jabal, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 15 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Amra, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 30 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Hula, the Mines Advisory Group organization detonated 30 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
9 March	0730	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP35(1), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of two Merkava tanks approached. They crossed the technical fence through the iron gate, deployed inside occupied Lebanese territory, and pointed their cannons at Lebanese army and UNIFIL personnel. At 0810 hours, near point TP36, a hostile patrol consisting of 17 soldiers and a dog approached. They opened and crossed the iron gate in the technical fence, conducted a foot patrol in the direction of point TP35(1), and deployed inside occupied Lebanese territory. At 0830 hours, in occupied territory, an enemy engineering vehicle approached. Six personnel in military uniform disembarked, planted metal posts around a minefield located inside occupied Lebanese territory between points TP35(1) and TP36, wrapped barbed wire around them, and posted signs warning of the danger of

		landmines. At 1200 hours, at point TP35(1), a hostile patrol consisting of 14 personnel in military uniform approached. They conducted a foot patrol inside occupied Lebanese territory along the road previously built by the municipality of Udaysah from point TP35(2) to a point across from point TP36. They then left in the direction of occupied territory. At 1405 hours, the two tanks left with all the enemy personnel in the direction of occupied territory. The violation was viewed from occupied territory by the Israeli press between 0930 hours and 1030 hours, and by a UNIFIL liaison unit patrol.
	–	In Lebanese territory in the town of Bustan, the DanChurchAid organization detonated eight landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy.
