Land violations committed in January 2022

	0715	From occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Aytarun and points BP25 and BP26, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 26 individuals in military clothing escorted by a military vehicle and a civilian pick-up truck approached and made an opening in the technical fence opposite point B56. Twenty patrol members crossed the fence through the opening and searched the spot, and one patrol member pointed his weapon at a Lebanese Army patrol in the presence of a patrol of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 0910 hours.
	0720	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 11 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other four took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	1400	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Duhayrah, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory until 1430 hours.
5 January	–	Some 10 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha‘b.
	0110	From occupied Palestinian territory, Israeli enemy soldiers fired two flares that landed in Lebanese territory near the village of Yarun.
6 January	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 8 in Mays al-Jabal and 11 in Alma al-Sha‘b.
	0730	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 13 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members

Three individuals in military clothing disembarked and fired three shots into the air in the direction of Lebanese territory. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1440 hours.
7 January	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 11 in Mays al-Jabal, 10 in Alma al-Sha‘b and 8 in Marwahin.
9 January	0730	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 11 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other four took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.

	1515	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Wazzani at the Israeli enemy Humayri position, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of eight individuals in military uniform approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1610 hours.
12 January	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 14 in Mays al-Jabal, 13 in Alma al-Sha‘b, 7 in Marwahin, 6 in Duhayrah and 14 in Yarun.
	0710	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 11 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members

	0715	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP35, Israeli enemy soldiers opened the metal gate in the technical fence. A Merkava tank and nine individuals crossed the technical fence and pointed their weapons and the tank cannon towards Lebanese territory.
16 January	0700	According to the operations room of the Force Commander Reserve unit of UNIFIL, on 16 January between 0113 and 0132 hours, the unit’s radar detected three flares fired by the Israeli enemy from the occupied side. The flares landed inside Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Bustan.
	2115	Israeli enemy soldiers fired six flares near the Ramta position as several bursts of gunfire were heard near the aforementioned site.

Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon four patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other four took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	0745	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Wazzani, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of two military four-wheel drive vehicles and a civilian car approached. Ten individuals in military clothing disembarked, opened the metal gate in the technical fence and crossed the fence, proceeding about 100 m beyond it. They took up positions west of the fence and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory as the Merkava tank was stationed east of the fence, pointing its cannon towards Lebanese territory. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 0950 hours.
	0850	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the towns of Mays al-Jabal and Kurum al-Shiraqi, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 30 individuals in military clothing and a dog, escorted by a Defender vehicle, approached the dirt road, opened the metal gate and crossed the technical fence opposite point B64. At 0910 hours, a Mitsubishi vehicle approached from occupied territory, escorted by a white Rapid vehicle, two GMC four-wheel drive vehicles and a Humvee equipped with a camouflage smoke generator. 	2345 and 2355	Opposite the town of Khiyam near point B90, Israeli enemy soldiers fired two flares that landed in Lebanese territory.
19 January	0945	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the towns of Mays al-Jabal and Kurum al-Shiraqi and points B64(1) and B65, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of a white pick-up truck and three Defender vehicles approached. Some 17 individuals in military clothing disembarked, opened the metal gate in the technical fence opposite point B64 and searched the area between points B64(1) and B64, escorted by a Merkava tank that pointed its cannon towards Lebanese territory. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1030 hours.

	1600	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Hula at the Israeli enemy Shaykh Abbad position, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of eight individuals in military uniform approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1630 hours.
24 January	–	Some 25 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha‘b.
25 January	–	Some 25 landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha‘b.
28 January	2345	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Kila near point B84, Israeli enemy soldiers fired two flares that landed in Lebanese territory.
