**Land violations committed in November 2022**

1 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 21 in Naqurah, 20 in Yarun, 5 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 25 in Amra, 4 in Markaba, 70 in Marwahin and 22 in Duhayrah.
2 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Naqurah, 29 in Marwahin, 26 in Duhayrah, 24 in Yarun, 12 in Amra, 5 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 12 in Markaba.
3 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 5 in Mays al-Jabal, 16 in Naqurah, 73 in Marwahin, 23 in Duhayrah, 26 in Yarun, 34 in Hula and 25 in Amra.
	0900	Inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms, in the vicinity of the Israeli enemy Ruwaysat al-Alam position, Israeli enemy personnel conducted bulldozing work on the dirt road along the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations) using a bulldozer, a trench-digger and two trucks for transporting basecourse. They proceeded to place the material inside a trench alongside the road to cover an approximately 300-metre-long electric cable. They were escorted by a patrol consisting of a black vehicle and nine soldiers who deployed and took up combat positions in the surrounding area. The patrol left in the direction of the aforementioned position at 1700 hours.
4 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 14 in Marwahin, 9 in Duhayrah, 24 in Yarun, 19 in Hula, 23 in Amra and 9 in Markaba.
6 November	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of a bulldozer, a truck, a civilian car and five personnel in civilian clothing approached. They crossed the technical fence and conducted levelling work on the road opposite the Wazzani pump in the direction of point SD1. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1600 hours.
	1720	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Marun al-Ras, at points BP21 and B51, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of four Hummer vehicles and five personnel in military uniform approached. They launched 14 flares, most of which landed inside Lebanese territory, which caused a fire opposite point BP21(1).
	–	Opposite the town of Aytarun, from inside the Malikiyah position, the Israeli enemy launched two 155 mm phosphorous shells that landed inside Lebanese territory.
7 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 4 in Mays al-Jabal, 26 in Naqurah, 46 in Marwahin, 11 in Duhayrah, 53 in Yarun and 2 in Arab al-Luwayzah.

They crossed the fence and laid pipe in the trench previously dug alongside the road opposite the Wazzani pump in the direction of point SD1. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1600 hours.
8 November	1130	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Hula, at the Israeli enemy Shaykh Abbad position, a group consisting of 10 personnel in military uniform approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1545 hours.
9 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 1 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 19 in Markaba.
	0900	In occupied Palestinian territory, in the vicinity of point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of two civilian vehicles approached. Four personnel in civilian clothing disembarked, installed three cameras on a pole at the location, and pointed them at Lebanese territory. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1910 hours.
	2120– 2145	In the occupied Shab‘a Farms, Israeli enemy personnel launched two flares over the Radar position.
10 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 6 in Mays al-Jabal, 7 in Balida, 12 in Naqurah, 3 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 23 in Amra and 1 in Markaba.
	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Markaba, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory.
		In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of seven personnel in civilian clothing, a civilian car and a bulldozer approached. In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of five personnel in civilian clothing, a civilian car and a bulldozer approached. They crossed the fence, worked on levelling the road, and placed metal construction materials alongside the dirt road opposite the Wazzani pump in the direction of point SD1. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1615 hours.
	0950	In occupied territory, on the outskirts of the town of Wazzani, while a team from the Mines Advisory Group was working in a minefield opposite the Israeli enemy Humayri position, seven personnel in military uniform approached. They crossed the fence, worked on levelling the road, and placed metal construction materials alongside the dirt road opposite the Wazzani pump in the direction of point SD1. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1640 hours.
17 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 22 in Balida and 20 in Naqurah.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of six personnel in civilian clothing, a civilian car, four cement mixers, a cement pump and a bulldozer approached. They crossed the fence, worked on levelling the road parallel to the SD1 road, and poured cement over metal construction materials opposite the Wazzani pump in the direction of point CP3 belong to the Spanish contingent. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1640 hours.
	0900	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Blida, in the vicinity of point BP28, while an Israeli enemy trench-digger was clearing brush, its boom crossed the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line) into Lebanese territory by a distance of about half a metre.
	1000	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Udaysah, at point TP 37, an Israeli enemy group consisting of 40 personnel in military uniform approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1045 hours.
	1530	In occupied Palestinian territory, on the outskirts of the town of Mays al-Jabal, in the Kurum al-Marah area at point B66, while several farmers were working in their fields near the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line), two Israeli enemy Humvees approached. Five personnel in military uniform disembarked and opened fire above the farmers to frighten them. There were no injuries. The two vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory at 1625 hours.
18 November	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 24 in Yarun, 17 in Amra, 3 in Markaba and 9 in Arab al-Luwayzah.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of seven personnel in civilian clothing, three civilian cars, five cement mixers, a cement pump and a bulldozer approached. They crossed the fence, worked on levelling the road, placed metal construction materials alongside the road, and poured cement over the metal opposite the Wazzani pump in the direction
