**Land violations committed in December 2022**

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
1 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 14 in Naqurah, 20 in Blida, 6 in Mays al-Jabal, 6 in Yarun, 28 in Duhayrah, 44 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 22 in Amra.
	–	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the village of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by installing wooden structures along the road, mounting metal bars within it and pouring concrete onto it.
	0630	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Markaba near point B78, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of four four-wheel drive vehicles, three civilian vehicles, two trench diggers and an armoured vehicle approached. Twenty individuals in military uniform disembarked, accompanied by a patrol from the liaison unit of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL). The enemy soldiers opened the metal gate in the technical fence, and the two trench diggers and the armoured vehicle crossed the fence. The Israeli enemy continued breaking up the ground and lifting mounds of earth between points B78 and B78-1 without violating the withdrawal line (the Blue Line). The machine gun mounted atop the armoured vehicle was pointed towards Lebanese territory. While carrying out their work, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannons of two Merkava tanks towards Lebanese territory. The work ended at 1630 hours, and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
	0900	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Alma al-Sha'b, two Namer armoured vehicles were stationed near the Hanita barracks. A Merkava tank stationed among the trees pointed its cannon towards Lebanese territory.
	2120 and 2145	In the occupied Shab'a Farms, Israeli enemy soldiers fired two flares over the Radar position.
2 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 12 in Naqurah, 6 in Mays al-Jabal, 22 in Blida, 11 in Duhayrah, 28 in Yarun and 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah.
	0745	In the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the outskirts of the town of Hasbayya in the locality of Ayn Tanurah, while Syrian civilian Ali Khaluf Taha was harvesting olives inside a field belonging to the civilian Raghieb Sa'id Halabi, a cluster bomb left by the Israeli enemy exploded, injuring him with shrapnel in the back.

3 December	1110 and 1154	In the occupied Shab‘a Farms, opposite the towns of Sarda and Amrah, a Merkava tank pointed its cannon towards Lebanese territory, and a foot patrol consisting of 11 members was deployed near the technical fence.
4 December	1430 and 1530	In the occupied Shab‘a Farms, two Merkava tanks exited the Israeli enemy’s Ruwaysat al-Alam position near the technical fence opposite point OP3. They released camouflage smoke, took up positions behind the earthen berm and pointed their cannons towards Lebanese territory.
5 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 8 in Mays al-Jabal, 10 in Naqurah, 15 in Blida, 2 in Duhayrah and 7 in Yarun.
	–	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the village of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by installing wooden structures along the road, mounting metal bars within it and pouring concrete onto it.
	0645	In occupied Lebanese territory opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP36, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of four military four-wheel drive vehicles, three civilian vehicles, two trench diggers, three D9 bulldozers, a wheeled bulldozer, two Merkava tanks and an armoured vehicle approached. Twenty individuals in military uniform disembarked, along with a patrol from the UNIFIL liaison unit. Several of the patrol members opened the metal gate in the technical fence, and the vehicles crossed the fence. The Israeli enemy continued breaking up the ground and lifting mounds of earth between points TP36 and point TP35 inside occupied Lebanese territory, escorted by the armoured vehicle and the two tanks, whose cannons were then pointed towards Lebanese territory. At 1330 hours, the Israeli enemy installed concertina wire along the dirt road that had been built previously. The work ended at 1750 hours, and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
6 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 20 in Duhayrah, 49 in Marwahin, 3 in Mays al-Jabal, 16 in Blida, 9 in Naqurah, 9 in Hula, 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah and 42 in Yarun.
	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP36, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of four military four-wheel drive vehicles, three civilian vehicles, two trench diggers, a wheeled bulldozer, one Merkava tanks and a Namer armoured vehicle approached, along with a patrol from the UNIFIL liaison unit. Ten individuals disembarked. Several of the patrol members opened the metal gate in the technical fence, and the vehicles crossed the fence. The Israeli enemy continued breaking up the ground and lifting mounds of earth between points TP36 and point TP35 inside occupied Lebanese territory and laid down concertina wire along the dirt road. The tank pointed its cannon towards Lebanese territory. At 0900 hours, the enemy soldiers pointed their weapons towards a

		Lebanese Army patrol. The work ended at 1315 hours, and the vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.
7 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 18 in Mays al-Jabal, 16 in Blida, 40 in Marwahin, 22 in Duhayrah and 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah.
	0800	In the locality of Ibil al-Qamh, opposite the town of Sarda, Israeli enemy soldiers fired light and medium machine guns. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1200 hours.
8 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 24 in Hula, 7 in Amra, 1 in Mays al-Jabal, 25 in Blida, 3 in Naqurah, 10 in Duhayrah, 27 in Marwahin and 10 in Yarun.
	1100	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Kafr Kila near point B82, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 25 individuals in civilian dress and military uniform approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1130 hours.
9 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 9 in Blida, 19 in Naqurah, 17 in Marwahin and 13 in Yarun.
	1307	Opposite the town of Hula, two Israeli enemy soldiers approached from the Shaykh Abbad position and took photographs of Lebanese territory.
10 December	1314– 1320	Opposite the town of Kafr Shuba at point OP3, a Merkava tank pointed its cannon towards Lebanese territory.
	2005	In occupied territory, opposite the town of Wazzani at the Maysat point, an Israeli enemy Humvee vehicle approached. Two individuals in military uniforms disembarked and fired four shots into the air towards Lebanese territory. No one was harmed. The vehicle left in the direction of occupied territory at 2025 hours.
	2005	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the Maysat (Wazzani) point, an Israeli enemy Humvee vehicle approached from occupied territory. Two individuals in military uniforms carrying photodetectors disembarked and fired four shots towards Lebanese territory.
11 December	1200– 1700	In occupied Palestinian territory east of Markaba, opposite the town of Udaysah, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory.
12 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 28 in Marwahin, 9 in Duhayrah, 3 in Mays al-Jabal, 23 in Blida, 8 in Naqurah, 14 in Amra and 10 in Yarun.
	1030 and 1110	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Kafr Kila, an Israeli enemy group consisting of 45 individuals approached. They scouted the area and took photographs of the Lebanese side.

13 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 3 in Yarun, 2 in Mays al-Jabal, 8 in Amra, 42 in Hula, 14 in Duhayrah, 55 in Marwahin, 11 in Naqurah and 22 in Blida.
	0700	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP35(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of two D9 bulldozers, two trench diggers, two Merkava tanks and two Namer armoured vehicles approached. Ten individuals in military uniform disembarked, along with a patrol from the UNIFIL liaison unit. The soldiers opened the metal gate in the technical fence, and vehicles and the two tanks crossed the fence. The bulldozers started operating in occupied Lebanese territory. One of the bulldozers then crossed the withdrawal line (the Blue Line to which a claim is maintained). The bulldozer dug a dip approximately 6 m deep and 100 m long, then left in the direction of occupied territory. At 1450 hours, enemy soldiers pointed a Merkava tank cannon towards Lebanese territory. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1700 hours.
14 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Naqurah, 2 in Mays al-Jabal and 3 in Yarun.
	0630	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah near point TP35(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of two D9 bulldozers, two trench diggers, two Merkava tanks, a wheeled bulldozer and two Namer armoured vehicles approached. Ten individuals in military uniform disembarked, along with a patrol from the UNIFIL liaison unit. The soldiers opened the metal gate in the technical fence, and the vehicles and the two tanks crossed the fence. The bulldozers started operating in occupied Lebanese territory. The enemy soldiers then pointed the cannons of the two tanks towards Lebanese territory. The work ended at 1830 hours, and the entire patrol left in the direction of occupied territory.
	1335 and 1345	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Kafr Kila, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory.
15 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 4 in Mays al-Jabal, 21 in Blida, 8 in Naqurah and 45 in Hula.
16 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 12 in Duhayrah, 5 in Mays al-Jabal, 9 in Naqurah, 3 in Hula and 57 in Arab al-Luwayzah.
	1654	On the outskirts of the town of Hula, members of an Israeli enemy patrol fired into the air towards Lebanese territory. Several civilians were present at the time. At 1715 hours, the patrol left in the direction of occupied territory.
18 December	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the village of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by installing wooden structures along the road, mounting metal bars within it and pouring concrete onto it.

	1905 and 2250	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Duhayrah, Israeli enemy soldiers fired 14 flares, 12 of which landed in occupied Palestinian territory. The other two landed in Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the towns of Duhayrah and Alma al-Sha'b, causing a fire to break out.
19 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 4 in Duhayrah, 16 in Marwahin, 1 in Mays al-Jabal, 16 in Blida and 6 in Naqurah.
	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the village of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by installing wooden structures along the road, mounting metal bars within it and pouring concrete onto it.
	1200	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Hula, at the Israeli enemy Shaykh Abbad position, Israeli enemy personnel pointed the cannon of a tank at Lebanese territory.
	1600	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Hula, at the Israeli enemy's Shaykh Abbad position, Israeli enemy personnel pointed the cannon of a tank towards Lebanese territory.
20 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 13 in Blida, 5 in Naqurah and 26 in Duhayrah.
	0630	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal near point B64, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of some 23 members in military uniform and a dog approached the technical road opposite the aforementioned point. They were escorted by four Defender vehicles, from which eight individuals in civilian dress disembarked. At 1700 hours, they crossed the technical fence and took photographs of the Lebanese side.
21 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 1 in Mays al-Jabal, 15 in Blida and 12 in Naqurah.
	0700	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Sarda near point BP38, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of three civilian vehicles, three military vehicles, a trench digger, a wheeled bulldozer, a Namer personnel carrier and a Merkava tank accompanied by a patrol from the UNIFIL liaison unit approached. Fifteen individuals disembarked from the enemy vehicles, opened the metal gate and crossed the technical fence. The personnel carrier, the Merkava tank and the elements took up positions behind the earthen berm near point BP38. The machine guns mounted on the personnel carrier and the tank were then pointed towards Lebanese territory. At 0930 hours, enemy soldiers threw a smoke bomb, which fell inside Lebanese territory. No one was harmed.
22 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 1 in Mays al-Jabal, 15 in Blida and 19 in Naqurah.

23 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 15 in Blida and 10 in Naqurah.
27 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 1 in Mays al-Jabal, 13 in Blida and 8 in Naqurah.
	0900	In occupied Palestinian territory opposite the town of Sahl al-Khiyam, three Israeli enemy civilian vehicles and three military four-wheel-drive vehicles approached. Six individuals in military uniform disembarked, scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. At 0950 hours, they left in the direction of occupied territory.
	1650	On the outskirts of the town of Hula, with several civilians present, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of five individuals approached from the other side. They threw three sound bombs next to the fence without crossing the withdrawal line (the Blue Line to which a claim is maintained). At 1700 hours, the patrol left in the direction of occupied territory.
28 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 1 in Mays al-Jabal, 12 in Blida and 9 in Naqurah.
29 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 2 in Mays al-Jabal, 21 in Blida and 3 in Naqurah.
	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the village of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by installing wooden structures along the road, mounting metal bars within it and pouring concrete onto it.

19 December	0940	An Israeli enemy reconnaissance aircraft violated Lebanese airspace, entering over the sea west of Damur. It proceeded as far as Beirut and circled over Beirut and its suburbs, Ba'abda and Alayh before leaving at 1320 hours over the sea west of Damur.
27 December	2010	An Israeli enemy drone violated Lebanese airspace, entering opposite Mays al-Jabal. It circled at medium altitude for some 100 m, proceeding as far as the town's neighbourhoods before leaving at 2035 hours in the direction of occupied territory.
